



Friday 14 | Depart USA

Depart USA for Dublin, Ireland

Saturday 15 | Arrive Dublin to Athlone (1 night)

Arrive Dublin where your guide and driver will be waiting to greet you and take you to Glasnevin Cemetery for a guided tour west to Athlone the heart of Ireland's midlands. Some time to enjoy the town and relax before evening dinner and an opportunity to spend some time in Sean's Bar, considered to be the oldest bar in Ireland.

Sunday 16 | Athlone to Galway and Clifden (2 nights)

Depart Athlone after breakfast and travel to the Cliffs of Moher for some time to explore. Journey along the shores of Galway Bay to arrive in the city of Galway where you will have time to stroll and explore at your leisure before making your way out through rugged Connemara with its unique mountain and bog landscape. Arrive in the town of Clifden and check in to your castle hotel for overnight and dinner.

Monday 17 | St. Patrick's Day in Clifden

Leisurely breakfast at the hotel followed by a free day to enjoy the town of Clifden and participate in the St. Patrick's Day activities. Option will be offered for local touring. Evening dinner at your castle hotel.

Tuesday 18 | Clifden to Derry (2 nights)

Leaving Clifden travel through Leenane and into Co. Mayo as you journey along Killary Harbour through Connemara toward Sligo. Visit Creevykeel Court Cairn before continuing further north to Donegal as you head to Derry City for overnight and dinner.



Wednesday 19 | Day tour of Inishowen Peninsula

Depart on a tour of the Inishowen Peninsula, the largest peninsula in Ireland and its most northerly point at Malin Head, Enjoy lunch in the pub at McGrorys and maybe even a few tunes from the Bhoys. Return to Derry for overnight with evening at leisure on your own to explore.

Thursday 20 | Derry to Belfast via the Giants Causeway (1 night)

Depart Derry this morning and travel to the Giants Causeway where you will visit this unique formation of basalt hexagonal rocks that makes up this part of the Antrim Coastline. Later travel south to the city of Belfast and enjoy a panoramic tour of the city before checking into your hotel for overnight and dinner.

Friday 21 | Belfast to Dublin (2 nights)

Visit Crumlin Road Jail before departing Belfast to head directly for Dublin where you will have the opportunity to record a song with the Wild Colonial Bhoys at Windmill Lane Studios (some time will be spent practicing during the week on the bus). Later you will have the evening to explore Dublin on your own.

Saturday 22 | Dublin

Morning panoramic tour of the city, and the afternoon at leisure to explore on your own, get in some last-minute sightseeing and shopping, before enjoying a farewell dinner and performance by the Bhoys at Nancy Hand's Pub.

Sunday 23 | Dublin to USA or extend in Dublin

Group transfer to Dublin airport or extend.
